


## LAET Maths Transition to A-Level programme

Welcome everyone to the LAET Maths Transition to A-Level programme.

We are looking forward to welcoming you to the school after the Summer.

To enable you to confidently approach the start of your A-Level Maths studies (and for some of you Further Maths as well), we need you to complete a specially designed online programme. This programme covers the key areas from your GCSE that you will need to be confident with including algebra, trigonometry, number and sketching.

## **Instructions for All Maths A-Level Students**

Begin by completing the Introduction worksheet. You will need to complete **2 online worksheets each week** through July and August and then complete **2 tests** at the end. You may complete the worksheets early if you wish but we would prefer you to allocate around 2 hours each week as you are then likely to get the most out of the programme. *The worksheets are labelled LAET Introduction, LAET 1 to 10 & LAET Test 1 and 2*.

Enter **your own personal email** here (simply remove the laetottenham prompt). The school will **not** see this but will be able to see how you are getting on with the work. Please register under a **different** email if you already have a Dr Frost account or email <u>maths@laetottenham.ac.uk</u> to switch accounts You should contact <u>maths@laetottenham.ac.uk</u> if you cannot access the Dr Frost site or you have any difficulty accessing the worksheets once you are in. All worksheets should be <u>seen</u> under "Work Set"

If you are not confident on any questions you will find videos on DFM to help you and worked answers to review any questions you get wrong. The system will mark your questions as you proceed through and give you an opportunity to review your answer before submitting. Once you have completed a worksheet you will receive an overall mark. If you want to reattempt questions the system will allow you to 'redo' worksheets as many times as you wish.
